The entry fee is £40 payable by cheque **and must be sent with entry form otherwise entry will not be accepted.** (£20 for members) This includes a baguette for lunch. In addition, there will be voluntary sweeps payable on the day.

Entries will close at 12 noon on Wednesday 9th May 2012 after which all entrants will be notified of acceptance (or non acceptance if the entry is oversubscribed). No refunds after the closing date.

EASTERN COUNTIES CUP CONDITIONS

The competition is open to any amateur ("Active" handicap 12 or less) who is a full member of any affiliated golf club in the counties of Suffolk, Norfolk, Cambridgeshire or Essex.

Entries will only be accepted on the above form which should be detached and sent to the General Manager of Woodbridge Golf Club

The competition will consist of 36 holes medal play, played on handicap.

The competitor returning the best net score for the 36 holes will hold the Cup until the following year when he shall return it, at his own risk and expense, to the General Manager of Woodbridge Golf Club.

There will be a prize for the runner up and a prize for the best scratch score.

There will also be prizes for 1st, 2nd & 3rd places in both the morning and afternoon rounds but no competitor may win more than one prize.

Ties will be decided on the best second round or the last 9 holes (10 to 18 on the card).

If the entry is oversubscribed, there will be a ballot. Places will be allotted in proportion to the number of applications received in each of the Categories 1 & 2.

Failure to comply with these conditions will render the competitor liable to disqualification at the discretion of the committee. Any dispute must be referred to the committee in writing. The decision of the committee will be final. The committee also reserves the right to refuse any entry and to make such alterations to the conditions as considered necessary.

Notes: 1. This is a qualifying competition and, in entering, all players acknowledge themselves bound to report their scores to their Home club.
